



AIRLINE INFORMATION

The airlines having flights to Argentina are United, American, Delta, Continental, Aerolineas Argentinas, and Lan Chile arriving to Buenos Aires International Airport from Miami, New York, Chicago, Atlanta, Dallas-Fort Worth, Houston, Los Angeles and Washington D.C. Most international are nine to ten hours in duration and depart in the evening from the cities above.

Remember that by now all the flights that go to Esquel (EQS) or Bariloche (BRC) depart from the Domestic airport in Buenos Aires (Aeroparque Jorge Newbery – AEP). Esquel has one flight 4 days a week and Bariloche has several flights a day everyday. The drive from Bariloche is 3 hours to reach Esquel .

BUENOS AIRES (AEP) – ESQUEL (EQS)

The flights to Esquel are on Tuesday, Thursday, Saturday and Sunday departing from Buenos Aires (AEP) 12:50 and arriving like 15:30. The Flights from Esquel (EQS) to Buenos Aires (AEP) depart the same days (Tuesday, Thursday, Saturday and Sunday) at 16:05 arriving around 18:30. This service is provided by Aerolineas Argentinas. (Always check for changes on the schedule)

BUENOS AIRES (AEP) – BARILOCHE (BRC)

Lan and Aerolineas Argentinas have several daily flights to Bariloche.

Travel Tips:

- If your flight is cancelled or delayed, please send an email to martin@patagoniafins.com and info@patagoniafins.com . You can also leave a message or call at +54 9 349 4400 (Martin).
- If travelling through Santiago or Lima, do NOT go through immigrations or customs in Chile or Peru. You are just connecting on a flight and should not go through immigration.
- If travelling through Buenos Aires, you will need to go through customs and immigration. You will need to transfer to a separate airport (domestic airport terminal) about 30 minutes away. It is important to have at least 2.5 hours between international arrival and domestic departure.
- If you need a person to assist you for your transfer from Ezeiza to Buenos Aires or to the domestic Airport (AEP) , please call or write us so we can contact you with a travel assistant, that can help you in Buenos Aires also if you plan to spend some time at the city.

- Starting in January 2010 there is now an entry fee of \$131 that is payable at the airport with cash or credit card. This is a reciprocal fee that is the same amount that the U.S. charges Argentines to enter the U.S. This will allow you to enter Argentina for up to 10 years.
- Buenos Aires is an interesting city with exciting attractions, beautiful architecture, and many fun activities and restaurants to enjoy also it has a very attractive night life. Staying the night in Buenos Aires allows the best opportunity to rest and relax before your fly fishing adventure. City tours, tango shows, art tours, architecture tours, dinner, and many more reservations can be made by our travel assistants. Remember that dinner time is very late in Argentina and most of the restaurants will not open before 9 pm.
