

MOST COMMONLY ASKED QUESTIONS

- When is the fishing season? It runs from November to April.
- When is the best time? Fishing is guaranteed all the time, the only difference is the weather and the level of water for the floating of Chubut River (November to February). There are several spring creeks and lowland rivers that are constant on temperature and water level the hole season. With us you will fish always.
- What is the weather like in Esquel Now ? You can visit the the following link: http://weather.uk.msn.com/local.aspx?wealocations=wc:ARCT0132&q=Esquel%2c+ARG. Then November and December cool to cold mornings and nights (32 to 70 F), January and February hot and dry during the day and cool night and mornings (50 – 85 F). March and April like November and December.
- Who will meet us at the airport? In Esquel or Bariloche you will be met by a representative
 or your fishing guide that will assist you on whatever is needed. After that he will drive you to
 Esquel.
- What forms of payment are accepted? Because the fishing trips are almost all inclusive, there are no big expenses during the trip. But in case of need we accept personal checks or cash. Sorry no Credit cards.
- Do I need a visa? No if you are a US Citizen but starting in January 2010 there is now an
 entry fee of \$131 that is payable at the airport with cash or credit card. This is a reciprocal fee
 that is the same amount that the U.S. charges Argentines to enter the U.S. This will allow you
 to enter Argentina for up to 10 years.
- Can I rent fishing and wading gear? By now depending on the group size we can rent
 fishing gear. We cannot provide any wading gear.
- Do I need to bring my own flies. It is strongly recommended that you do so. There is a list of
 the most common flies used at Esquel. There is the possibility to purchase a selection of 25
 flies. If your guide sees that you need a fly that you don't have, he will provide it to you.
- Once I decide to book a trip, what do I have to do to reserve my dates? We require a nonrefundable deposit in the amount of 50% of the fishing trip. Deposits may be transferred to
 another fishermen but may not be applied to a future season or year. We recommend that all
 guests protect their investments and purchase trip cancellation insurance.
- Is Argentina a safe country? Argentina is probably the safest country in South America, and there have been no recorded threats directed against travelers or foreign tourists in Argentina. Robberies and thefts do occur, and we strongly urge you to use common sense when touring. Take the same precautions that you would if you were traveling in any large city where crime is an everyday occurrence. Your personal safety should not be taken for granted so we urge

you to maintain a high level of situational awareness when touring outside your hotel or when soliciting transportation. The most practical advice is don't wear expensive watches or jewelry around Buenos Aires.
